FUTURE OF EUROPE IN IOANNINA (GREECE)

The Richness of Diversity and the Lessons of the Past

A three-day event was held in loannina, Greece, from the 19th to the 21st of October, on the topic of "The richness of diversity in Europe and the lessons of the past, regarding the racial policies of the 1930s in Europe, the destruction of cultural and economic heritage".

FIGHTING THE EUROSCEPTICISM

The project is based on the organization of 7 different international events (workshops, seminars, heritage walking, storytelling)

In each partner town, citizens will be involved in debates on the future of Europe, based on lessons from the past, and developing ideas to combat euroscepticism and mental walls/barriers towards the others.


Their contributions will be summarized in a book that will be presented in the closing conference and sent to the European Commission The event was attended by youth ambassadors from Greece, Poland, Latvia, Italy, North Macedonia and Portugal.

During the first day, young people shared their views on the important subject that is diversity during the Tell your Story session.

They presented the actions implemented in their countries around this topic and focused on the diversity that exists today in their regions.



- Be a proactive listener.




